Definitions:

Magic Eight Ball: Toy for fortune telling, using numbers

Cabala: Jewish mysticism

I Ching: Divination using numbers

Swedenborgianism: Christian cult movement based upon Emanuel Swedenborg having 'new revelations' based upon a Jesus Only philosophy.

Rosicrucianism: built on supposed truths of the ancient past which were concealed from the average man, providing insight into nature, the physical universe and the spiritual realm, connected with Kabblah

Spiritual Frontiers Fellowship: interfaith, non-profit, mysticism philosophy based upon altered states of consciousness

EST: New Age, Human Growth Movement, All about you, not a divine being.

Eckankar: New Age, embrace Karma and reincarnation

Theosophical Society: Occultism, Cabala, Eastern Religion

Incubi and Succubi: An incubus is a demon in male form who, according to mythological and legendary traditions, lies upon sleepers, especially women, in order to engage in sexual activity with them. Its female counterpart is the succubus. Superstitious folk have for many centuries told salacious tales of incubi and succubi.
