The ARMOR of GOD

EPHESIANS 6:10-20

Ephesians 6:10-12

- ¹⁰ Finally, <u>be strong in the Lord</u> and in the strength of His might.
- 11 Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil.
- 12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places.

Ephesians 6:13

Therefore, take up the <u>full armor of God</u>, so that you will be able to <u>resist</u> in the <u>evil day</u>, and <u>having **done everything**</u>, to **stand firm**.

We need to put on the FULL ARMOR OF GOD. ALL OF THE ARMOR.

Ephesians 6:13-15

- 13 Therefore, put on every piece of God's armor so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm.
- 14 Stand your ground, putting on the <u>belt of</u> <u>truth</u> and the body armor of God's righteousness.
- ¹⁵ For <u>shoes</u>, <u>put on the peace</u> that comes from the Good News so that you will be fully prepared.

Ephesians 6:16-19

- In addition to all of these, hold up the <u>shield</u> of faith to stop the fiery arrows of the devil.

 Put on <u>salvation as your helmet</u>, and take the <u>sword of the Spirit</u>, which is the word of God.
- Pray in the Spirit at all times and on every occasion. Stay alert and be persistent in your prayers for all believers everywhere.

Ephesians 6:19

And pray for me, too. Ask God to give me the right words so I can boldly explain God's mysterious plan that the Good News is for Jews and Gentiles alike.

We wear the armor, we go to battle to conduct spiritual warfare. For who? Ultimately so the lost become born again.



Belt of Truth

Ephesians 6:14 Stand your ground, putting on the belt of truth.

They would be ready to share the Gospel.




Shield of Faith

They would be victorious warriors for Jesus Christ.




Helmet of Salvation

Ephesians 6:17

Put on salvation as your helmet,

Sword of the Spirit

Ephesians 6:17 and take the <u>sword of the Spirit</u>, which is the word of God.
